Medics

Medics grow best during the warmer conditions of autumn and spring, but a wet autumn will give a good bulk of feed for winter. This free-seeding annual legume is a low-growing species, prostrate but not rooting from the nodes...

Medics (Medicago spp.)

- Early-mid maturing
- Early to mid season – approx 90 days to flowering
- Erect growth habit with high herbage and seed production
- Adaptable variety which grows on wide range of soils
- Better water logging tolerance



- Early-mid maturing
- Early to mid season – approx 90 days to flowering
- Erect growth habit with high herbage and seed production
- Maturity is 7 days later than Santiago
- Adaptable variety which grows on wide range of soils
- High percentage of soft seed (24%) – Santiago (8.5%)
- Increased salinity tolerance over other medics
- Better water logging tolerance
